### **Information on Activities and Services On Behalf of Undocumented Students Provided by the Colleges of the Los Angeles Community College District February 1, 2017**

#### **Los Angeles Mission College**

Deferred Action for Childhood Arrival (DACA) students at Los Angeles Mission College (LAMC) are provided an array of student services such as assistance with matriculation into the college, counseling, financial aid, and other essential services that support student success. In our efforts to proactively support DACA students, particularly in light of our concerns with regard to their enrollment status, we recommend the following:

1. Dr. Christopher Villa, Vice President of Student Services, be designated as the single point of contact for LAMC. Contact Information: (818) 364-7766 and [VillaCM@lamission.edu](mailto:VillaCM@lamission.edu).
2. Key departments such as Admissions & Records, Financial Aid, Counseling, etc. will identify a DACA liaison who will serve as advocates for DACA students. All liaisons will be expected to meet regularly with Ms. Villegas-Vidal in order to be the (1) first point of contact for DACA students, (2) serve as liaisons with community agencies and programs that serve DACA students and (3) to stay informed with regard to any modifications to current DACA requirements.
3. Identify space on campus for DACA students to be served. The office located adjacent to the ASO Conference Room on the bottom floor of the Campus Center will be the place for Counseling DACA students.
4. The College is hosting an Immigration Forum, February 21 for faculty, staff, and students during the college hour and provide legal, educational, and college information regarding undocumented students.

Finally, we have requested that the Office of Institutional Effectiveness at LAMC determine approximately how many undocumented students are enrolled at LAMC, and what number and percentage of those are DACA.
